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1. Objectives of the Native Greenland foundation

The objectives of the Native Greenland foundation are:

- To support the indigenous people of Greenland in rediscovering their cultural and spiritual identity.
- To look for solutions to the social problems and economic disadvantages experienced by the native residents.
- To promote the exchange of wisdom, knowledge and traditions of the native residents of Greenland with Western society.

In the broadest sense, the foundation also aims to carry out all other actions related to the aforementioned goals, or be beneficial to them.

2. Method of raising funds

Native Greenland foundation receives its assets through donations. These donations are given mainly by private individuals and companies.

3. Management of assets

Board

Native Greenland foundation has a board that is responsible for the management of the assets.

The board consists of three persons, namely a chairwoman, a secretary and a treasurer.

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Board activities

Meetings

The board meets at least twice a year for a board meeting. Minutes are made of these meetings.

Activities

The following activities are carried out under the responsibility of the Board:

1. Setting up and supervising projects.
2. Selecting destination targets.

Finances

The board is responsible for a healthy financial policy. The tasks involved include:

1. Draw up an annual budget.
2. Establishing and approving annual accounts.
3. Managing the funds.
4. Spending the funds and creating provisions.

Remuneration of board members

The board members do not receive any compensation for their board activities.

4. Use of assets

The assets shall be spent in accordance with the objective of Native Greenland foundation.

1. The income of the foundation shall in the first place be used to compensate the expenses.
2. The revenues are used to set up projects and activities.
3. The foundation's income may be used in the second place to support other initiatives that have a similar objective to that of the foundation.
4. The foundation does not aim to make a profit. It does want to maintain a healthy buffer in order to be able to absorb disappointing income. In addition, this will be reserved to develop and set up new activities.
